Since LDHS was launched in 11 May 2007, the Heritage Society has created the LDHS Archives, with donations coming from older village residents, former veterans of RAF Oakington and Oakington Barracks, and people from across the world whose family members were associated with the villages of Longstanton, Oakington and Westwick or the airfield. **These archives are now at risk if a heritage facility on Northstowe is not forthcoming. We continue to work with others to see what can be offered within the town centre, but we need significant support if this is to be achieved.**
